Dear Parents,

Annually, during Outdoor Education, the seniors head to Ashland, Oregon, to see six plays and participate in four workshops. We leave SRS Monday morning, 13 September, at 8:00 a.m. and travel by mini-vans through Susanville and Shasta to Ashland. This year, Nicole Taucare and Laurie Bissonette will lead the trip.

Students will want to plan to dress in layers; it gets cold, but it can also be very warm during the day. And sometimes, because it's Oregon, it rains.

Students may not wear denim or tee-shirts to any of the plays, and so should plan to pack accordingly.

I've attached Oregon State University information and our schedule during our stay in Ashland; it should help you know where the students are if you have an emergency.

We generally eat breakfast on or near campus, but take all other meals off campus. Plan on about \$30/day for meals.

Students are expected to follow all the normal SRS rules for behavior and are expected to participate in all activities. Those who do not meet our expectations will be sent home immediately at parents' expense. (Flights from Ashland are possible but expensive.) Please be sure to leave an emergency contact number with Ms. Stephens, and if you are planning to travel during Outdoor Education week, please leave the name and number of the person whom you have appointed as guardian and can pick up your child in an emergency.
