Reports:

Treasurer – Jeff Foster

Jeff presented a budget sheet with the previous and present years financial information, as well as a Proposed budget for next year. PA income from this was less than last year. Lunch Program – Suzanne Shapiro & Tina Montella

The decline in participation in the hot lunch program has initiated reconsideration of the present program. At the beginning of the school year there were 80 lunches served per day. Now there are 35 per day. Over the summer Suzanne and Tina will be revamping the lunch program, working with Colburn Shindell.

Volunteer Hours Report – Lisa Menante

Will be sending out the last update letter for hours as of April 15. This will go out to families as an email. July 1 is the cutoff date for volunteer hours for this school year. After July 1, Lisa will present a list of those families that have unfulfilled hours and have not paid for unfulfilled hours. Letters will be sent out from SRS notifying the families of the money they owe. As of May 4, 85 families have completed their hours requirement, 47 families have no hours logged. In the letter, Lisa reminds families that have volunteered but not logged their time to do so soon.

Spirit Clothing – Jason Chelius (not present)

No report. Spirit clothing is sold at Book Day, and takes individual orders during the rest of the year. However, the price of clothing does not cover the cost of individual orders and shipping, so PA actually loses money on those sales. Jason suggested doing some advanced ordering based on most common items and sizes, and sending that order in with the Book Day order. Then some items will be in stock. Individual orders will be combined until the total order is economically feasible.

Other suggested sale times might be Orientation Day for new students, the welcome BBQ, and perhaps a sidewalk sale sometime during the year.

Used Uniforms – Fiona Miller

There are no more sales planned. It was suggested that the June Ice Cream Social for new students and their families might be a good opportunity to sell used uniforms. Fiona will consider this.

Other recommended times were: Orientation Day at the beginning of the school year, and perhaps the Welcome BBQ.

New Business:

Budget As reported above, a budget was proposed and accepted for next year.

Flowers for Carol Murphy A motion was made and accepted to purchase flowers for Carol Murphy who's son passed away unexpectedly last week.

PA Shed Utilization The hinges on the PA storage shed have been repaired. The key to the storage shed is now in the hands of Amber Hodges in the main office. People will have to get the key from her. Access to the shed is limited to the PA and people helping with PA events that need access.

Scrip PA needs an income and Scrip was suggested to provide this income. Investigations were stalled. Catherine Cunningham and Colburn Shindell will continue the investigation.

At present, PA's income is limited to Used Clothing and Spirit Clothing sales. This is not enough to fund PA events. It's vital that PA to have an adequate and dependable income if it is to continue to provide support to Sage Ridge at the present scale.
